Plus an Evening Presentation: Saturday, May 21st, 7-9 pm

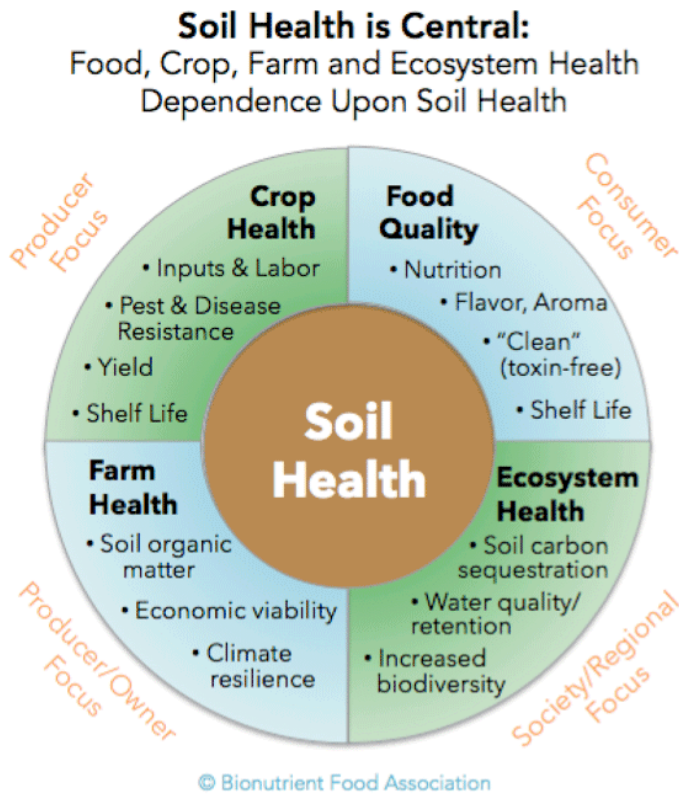
